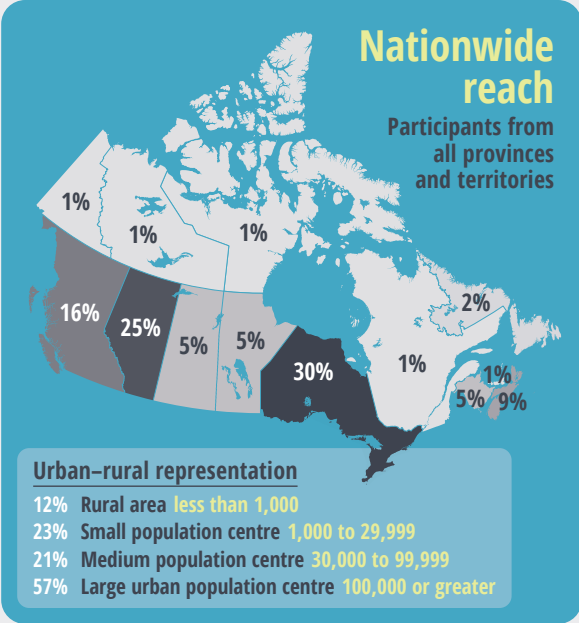
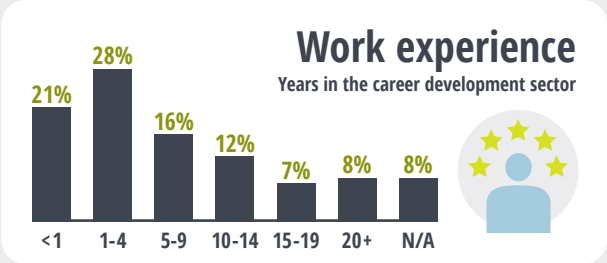

This course was part of the Guided Pathways project, a federally funded training and research project.

Top five populations served

- 68% Working-age adults
- 64% Unemployed job seekers
- 61% Adults in career transition
- 61% Immigrants, newcomers and/or refugees
- 52% New entrants or re-entrants to the labour market

Changes to practice as result of training

Immediately after training:

76% expected to make changes to their work with clients

Three months after training:

57% reported making changes to their work with clients



Relevance

Almost all participants found the training relevant to their professional development needs and goals

80% Very relevant

19% Somewhat relevant

98% of participants see a link between their clients' essential skills levels and their success in the workplace
